

**CONSTRUCTION INDUSTRY TRAINING COUNCIL OF WASHINGTON – Construction Equipment Operator**

**II. MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:**

- Age: **Not less than 18 years.**
- Education: **Applicant must have a high school diploma or equivalent at the time of application. A waiver for high school diploma/equivalent may be granted for applicants who can provide documentation that they have worked two (2) or more years in the constructions industry. All applicants must submit to the Apprenticeship Committee, a copy of documents showing proof of age, high school diploma or equivalent, DD-214 (if applicable), resume, work history, letters of recommendation, and additional information the applicant feels beneficial, within sixty (60) days after making application.**
- Physical: **The applicant must be physically and mentally able to perform the work of the trade.**
- Testing: **Scheig Utility Worker 1.0 Assessment. Must score a minimum of T-50.**
- Other: **Applicants must have a valid Washington State Driver’s License and dependable transportation.**
